Information for you about your .dk domain name

We are contacting you because you currently have your .dk domain name(s) handled by Punktum dk, and this will change in the future.

From 1 July 2026, Punktum dk will change the way we handle .dk domain names. This means that from this point on, it must be a registrar who handles your .dk domain name(s) and not Punktum dk. A registrar is where you typically have your website.

What does this mean for you?

Right now, nothing, and you do not have to worry about whether your website will work in the future, but we are writing to you because we have notified the registrars about this change and because your .dk domain name(s) is currently handled by us.

You don't need to do anything now – you'll hear from us when you have to choose a registrar.

It becomes easier to be a customer

We are making this change because we want to make it easy for you to have a .dk domain name, and because in the future you will only have to turn to one place when it comes to your .dk domain name.

By 2028, you must have chosen a registrar

From 1 July 2028, your .dk domain name can no longer be handled through Punktum dk, and you must therefore have chosen a registrar in the period between mid-2026 and 30 June 2028 at the latest.
